### FLORIADE, CANBERRA'S FAMOUS TULIP DISPLAYS

Friday 27 September 2024

Our 3 day tour begins as we board our coach & travel to Canberra. With a morning tea stop on the way, we aim to be in the nations capital by early lunch time. We will be dropped off at the gates of Floriade where we can purchase a lunch of our own choice at the many food stalls onsite.

**In 2020, Covid 19 saw the cancellation of the annual Floriade displays. The million bulbs and annuals for the display, were distributed to over 130 sites through the A.C.T. creating the Tulip Trail. Around 300,000 of them were distributed to community groups, not for profit organisations, clubs, schools and residents groups across Canberra.**

We then head over to Corbett Gardens, where there are approx. 100,000 bulbs blooming there way into Spring. We have ample time to wander the gardens which are close to the main street of Bowral too. You may wish to do a lap of the



arcades, hotels, bakeries, boutiques & cafes which are a short stroll away. Bowral is a beautiful township. This afternoon, we will be heading back to Penrith & Wallsend after a beautiful & memorable trip of tip toeing through our trio of tulip spring displays.
